These fun, easy going wines, made in the Beautiful Pyrenees ranges of Victoria, using traditional Techniques, reflect the unique style of the regions the soils in which they are grown. an elegant style this Pinot Noir offers bright red fruit flavours, excellent oak integration and firm acidity.
